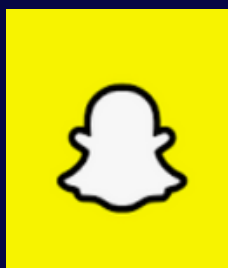


Keeping our students safe online

It can be difficult to navigate the ever changing world of online safety. We wanted to give you a quick guide to the most common social media apps and some useful info on parental controls and how you can keep your young person safe online.

The four C's of internet safety:

- **Content**- The extensive range of digital material, entertainment and media found online, including websites, apps, games and social media.
- **Conduct**-The behaviour of children and young people online.
- **Commerce**-The commercial aspects of the online world, such as advertising, online shopping, in-app purchases and the risks of online gambling and scams.
- **Contact**-The online interactions and connections between individuals.



Snapchat-Allows users to send and receive photos and videos, known as "Snaps," to other users. can also send voice notes, play games, and make private chats.

Some features on Snapchat, such as viewing non-followers, adding users not in your contacts, or attaching payments, require users to be at least 18 years old.

TikTok-Allows users to create, share, and watch short-form videos up to 60 seconds long. Also add effects, filters, and music. Videos can cover a wide range of topics, including comedy, dance, education, and more. Has a wide range of users across different age groups. TikTok prohibits content and behaviors that may be harmful to users, especially those under 18.



A parental control app helps parents monitor and limit their child's online activity, monitor messages, phone logs, and other activity, block access to specific apps, websites, or functions. Below are some apps that you can use.

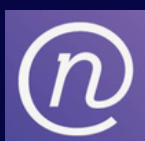
