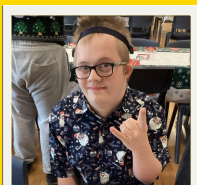
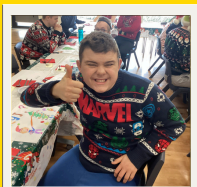


# Trent View College Newsletter

For those who weren't able to join us, we've included some photos below to give you a taste of the festive magic.

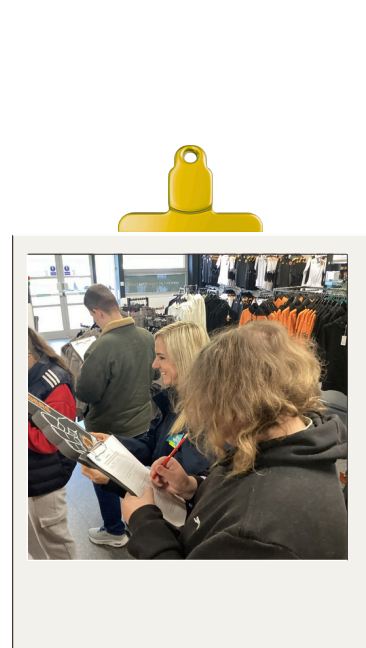
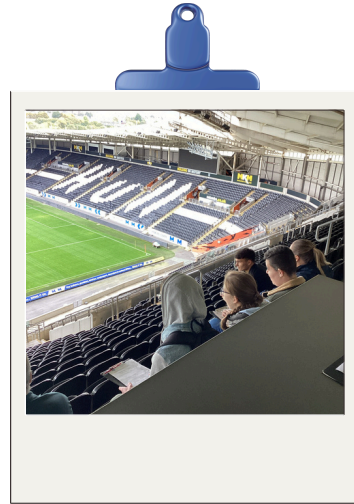
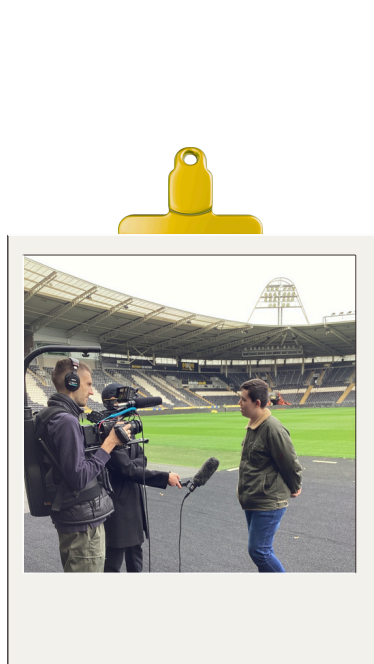
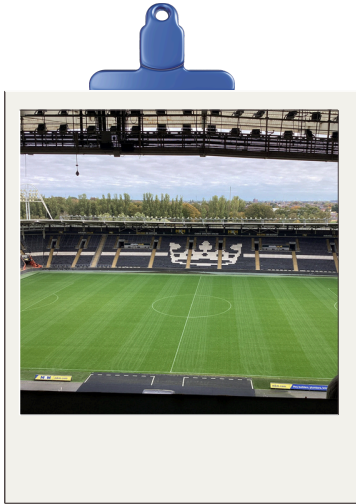

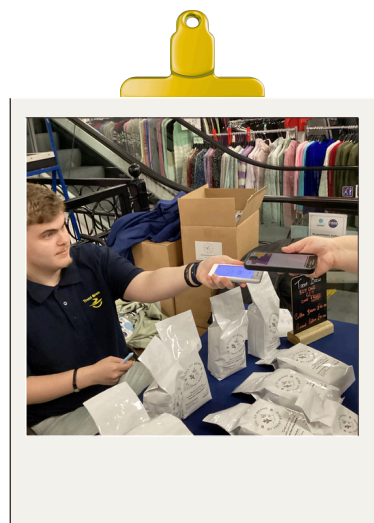


**It's been an action packed half term here at Trent View College!**
